The Project...

is a pilot project funded by the Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Climate Action and implemented by the Federal Employment Agency (BA) and the DIHK Service GmbH. The project is a joint pilot project of the Federal Employment Agency and DIHK Service GmbH, which is funded by the Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Climate Action. It supports companies in recruiting foreign skilled professionals on the basis of the Skilled Immigration Act. The second funding phase started in February 2024 and runs until the end of 2027.

Goals

The project partners develop and apply a practicable and transferable process to attract qualified specialists in CCI* professions from non-EU countries for companies in Germany. This approach is implemented in close cooperation with the German Federal Employment Agency, regional Chambers of Commerce and Industry (IHK) and German Chambers of Commerce Abroad (AHK).
